



VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATION: For the 2017-2018 school year, all parents need to log in to the Aeries Parent Portal to confirm their child's emergency information. We are asking parents to confirm information through the portal instead of sending home paperwork to make sure addresses, phone numbers, medical information, etc. are correct. You will also be asked to look over our school handbook and other important documents. After you finish confirming your information, you will be instructed to print out a form, sign it and bring it to the school office on or before the first day of school. This Data Confirmation Module will open July 24th and will be available until the first day of school. The day before school starts you will need to log into your parent portal to see who your child's homeroom teacher is. <u>You need to go through the Data Confirmation Module before you will see the teacher's name.</u>
